

ACTIVITIES

Onsite activities must be arranged in advance with the registrar and are available on a first come, first serve basis

In general, we do not charge for activities that do not require our staff to be present. However, some activities pose a safety risk or involve special equipment and necessitate a charge for special staffing or upkeep costs. Many activities are available during summer months, even while summer camp is in session.

Onsite Year Round Activities

Gymnasium at the Jackson Family Activity Center. Anytime the gym is not reserved is an open time where everyone is free to use the facility. Schedules will be posted at the gym. The gym is large enough to accommodate more than one group at a time when the dividing curtain is used. Sports equipment located in the gym. **No Charge**

Game Room at the Jackson Family Activity Center. Ping Pong, Billiards, Foosball, and game tables are available for use. No reservations needed. **No Charge**

Volleyball (both indoor and outdoor) **No Charge**

Carpet Ball is a simple but addicting game similar to one on one miniature bowling. No reservation needed. **No Charge**

Ping Pong set up requires advanced notification and is based on space availability. **No Charge**

Hiking Trails are marked on the grounds map. There is a lake path, which goes all 22 miles around Geneva Lake. You can take a nice walk into the town of Lake Geneva, it is approximately a 15-20 minute walk.

Tree Swing launches off of our tree house in Kishwaukee and is fun for smaller kids. Group staffing assistance helpful. **\$25/hour**

Mountain Boards are a cross between skateboarding and snowboarding. 20-25 riders per hour. **\$25/hour**

Archery accommodates about 15-20 people per hour. **\$25/hour**

Bounce Castle is a fun activity for the younger kids. **\$30/hour**

Campfires firewood will be provided and the campfire will be lit if requested. The group must make sure the fire is kept under control and remain at the fire until is completely extinguished. **\$25/fire**

Low Ropes Course year-round team building and team challenge. See **Snake Road Adventure Center pricing sheets for rates**

High Ropes Course year-round individual challenge. See **Snake Road Adventure Center pricing sheets for rates**

Climbing Tower climb up a 50-foot wall, come down a 300-foot zip line. See **Snake Road Adventure Center pricing sheets for rates**

Climbing Wall Room in the Jackson Family Activity Center in a separate room off of the gym with two 35 foot climbing walls and bouldering walls. Estimated completion 2010. See **Snake Road Adventure Center pricing sheets for rates**

Onsite Winter Activities

Ice Skate/Ski Rental available with a wide variety of sizes. Broomball equipment is also available. Groups are welcome to bring any of their own equipment. Rental fees are as follows (per half day):

Cross-country skis: \$5.00/pair

Ice-skates: \$3.00/pair

Broomball equipment: **No Charge**

Tubing Hill there are no lights on the hill, therefore nighttime tubing is not allowed. Harbor can provide tubes for free. **No Charge**

Onsite Warmer Weather Activities

Swimming is available Memorial Day-Labor Day when lifeguards are on duty. For safety reasons, no nighttime swimming is allowed. Water shoes are recommended due to Zebra Mussels in the lake. A waterfront orientation must be given prior to swimming. Groups coming with own lifeguards must show current certification and go through a training session with CHBC staff. Covenant Harbor can supply lifeguards as needed. The numbers of guards required are based on American Camping Association guidelines.

Covenant Harbor lifeguards

\$15/ hour per guard

minimum \$30 charge

In general, lifeguarding ratios are 1 guard for every 25 swimmers
