Covenant Harbor Bible Camp

1. **LABEL YOUR ITEMS.** Please write your camper's first and last name where possible, especially on disposable cameras and beach towels.
2. Please pack with your camper. It will help them know what they have throughout the day and what to bring home.
3. Send a backpack or other sealable bag with your camper. The bags can be stored in our Day Camp area with hooks and cubbies during the day and campers will have periodic access.

- ___ Swimsuit (modest 1 piece for girls, trunks for boys)
- ___ Water shoes (we have Zebra mussels in lake)
- ___ Closed toe and/or Athletic shoes (required for some activities and running games)
- ___ Beach towel
- ___ Sunscreen and Bug Spray
- ___ Water Bottle (camp has several drinking fountains where they can re-fill their bottles)
- ___ Raingear (check the forecast)
- ___ Jacket/Sweatshirt (check the forecast)

Optional: Especially PUT CAMPER'S NAME ON following items

- ___ Camera
- ___ Skateboard or In-line skates (for use in Skate Park only)
- ___ Helmet and skate pads (bring your own or use ours)

Weather at Covenant Harbor:

Our weather varies throughout the day with cool mornings and hot mid-days and afternoons. Weather also depends on the week your child attends camp. Layers that can be added or subtracted work well. We do have occasional rain; an extra pair of shoes might be nice in case the first get soaked.

Clothing choices:

Please do not bring your best clothes to camp, things may get dirty, stained, or lost. We desire for all campers to feel comfortable while they are at camp. For that reason, we ask that campers and our staff dress modestly. If an item of clothing is too revealing, we will ask the camper to change. Our high ropes (climbing tower/zip line) course requires closed toe shoes and longer shorts or pants.

What Not to Bring:

In order to create a safe, fun environment and new opportunities for campers, there are several things campers cannot bring to Harbor. Campers aren't allowed to bring cell phones or any electronic devices including DVDs, CDs, players, ipods/mp3 players, handheld electronic games, etc. Campers are also not allowed to bring pets, firearms, weapons of any kind, fireworks, tobacco, alcohol or drugs. If any electronic device is found, the staff member will confiscate it and return to parent at check out. Campers bringing firearms, drugs, etc. will be subject to immediate dismissal.

Lost and Found:

Covenant Harbor is not responsible for lost or stolen belongings. At Check-out, lost and found items are brought to a designated area. Once an item is discovered as "missing", please talk to a staff member while you are here, or call the office M-F, 8-5. Items can be mailed, but we ask for shipping reimbursement. At the end of the summer season, unclaimed items are donated to charity. For health reasons, socks and underwear will be thrown out.
